Time and Location:

- ❖ **June 6, 2018** at First Interstate Bank Center, DCFG - 7:00pm
- ❖ Doors open for guests at 6:00pm--no tickets necessary; "first come, first served" unlimited seating per family
- ❖ Graduates will report to the Event Center by 5:30pm on Commencement night
- ❖ Reserve ADA parking by calling Janet Bojanowski at (541) 504-3613.

Commencement Announcements/Caps and Gowns:

- ❖ Commencement announcements that were ordered through Miners will be distributed at lunch
April 3, 2018 in the Sky Box.
- ❖ Caps and gowns will be distributed **May 17** during lunch, again in the Sky Box.
- ❖ Caps and gowns should not be altered or added to in any way.
- ❖ Caps and gowns will be yours to keep after the ceremony.
- ❖ Caps and gowns are the only mandatory items that must be ordered through Miners for Commencement. If you have not ordered, please go online at www.minersgrad.com. If this requirement puts a strain on your budget, please see Mrs. Peterson in Student Management.

Commencement Rehearsals:

- ❖ Both rehearsals are **mandatory** to participate in the Commencement ceremony.
- ❖ Rehearsal dates and times-
 - June 4 – 12:00PM (RVHS)
 - June 6 - 10:00AM (FIBC Center/DCFG)
- ❖ **Transportation will NOT be provided to the Event Center for Commencement practice. Students are required to provide their own transportation to the fairgrounds.**
- ❖ Regular school dress code and behavior is expected during both practices

Commencement:

- ❖ Behavior:
 - o Students are expected to “stay classy” and not disrupt Commencement. Items that interfere with maintaining order are not allowed. Such items include, but are not limited to: water pistols, noise makers, silly string, matches, lighters, and laser pointers. Phones and other electronics should be silenced and put away. And tobacco, drugs, and alcohol or look-alike substances are prohibited. Let’s have a proud celebration!

- ❖ Photographer and Videographer
 - o Ridgeview High School has hired Lifetouch to photograph our ceremony. They will have several Lifetouch photographers on site prior to the event capturing candid moments before, during, and after Commencement. Each student will be photographed as they walk across the stage, shake hands with Administration and receive their diploma; and then after they leave the stage with a huge “I did it” smile!
 - o These photos will be available for purchase at events.lifetouch.com.
 - o Commencement ceremony video will be available to purchase for \$25 through COTV.
 - o Parents are asked to remain seated and not contact their student once Commencement has begun. An area for taking photographs will be provided during the ceremony.
