Welcome to Ridgeview High School! We hope this information will answer questions for you about enrolling in Ridgeview High School for 2019-2020 and what our school has to offer.

If you currently attend one of Ridgeview's Feeder Middle Schools (Obsidian Middle School or Tumalo Community School) and Ridgeview is your boundary high school, then you are already slated to attend Ridgeview. If your intention is to attend another high school (outside of your boundary high school), please contact your destination school to secure your place on their rosters.

**Obsidian Middle School (OMS) and Tumalo Community School (TCS) Families:**

Our counselors will visit your 8th graders at OMS and Tumalo in mid-February. Your students will receive and should complete the Scheduling Next Year's Classes forms ("forecasting sheets"), and turn them in when they visit Ridgeview on Future Freshmen Day (2/26/19). You must provide your own transportation. This event is for students only; parents and guardians are asked to sign up for a tour in order to see the building.

**8th Grade Parent Night:** We will be hosting an 8th Grade Parent Night in early May. Information is forthcoming and we will communicate through the middle schools about this event. Stand by for details!

**Non-feeder School Families:** If you do not attend OMS or TCS, you'll need to complete a transfer request form and apply for enrollment.
